

CURIOCIITY: HAWKESCAPES REDEMPTION TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. How do I participate?

From Mon, 5 May 2025 1000 hrs to Mon, 30 Jun 2025 2100 hrs (SGT), NLB is organising a quiz redemption to encourage participants to explore Singapore's rich heritage through digital story, story maps and videos on local food history. - ii. Answer six (6) questions correctly in the Curioicity: Hawkerscapes quiz;
- iii. Complete the quiz by providing your full name and email address.

All entries must be written in English.

2. Who can participate?

Any person who is living in Singapore can participate, except for:

- i. NLB staff and their immediate family members; and
- ii. Contractors for NLB who are involved in organising this contest.

You do not have to be an NLB member to participate.

3. What are the prizes?

Winners will each receive a \$10 Old Chang Kee voucher. While stocks last.

Prizes are not exchangeable for other gifts or for cash or other benefits.

4. Who will win the prizes?

A total of five hundred (500) participants who have answered all six (6) questions correctly will be able to redeem a \$10 Old Chang Kee value voucher (while stocks last).
